

The Easy Access Program is designed for those who wish to study part time and those not interested in actively pursuing a degree. Students may register for a maximum of six hours during the fall and spring semesters and three hours in the summer. Graduate credit is not allowed through Easy Access, and permission must be obtained from either the professor or the department prior to enrolling in courses requiring consent. Students wishing to participate in MU's evening program need to contact MU Direct at 573-882-3598 or at **MUDirect.missouri.edu**.

Bring a completed Easy Access application to 125 Jesse Hall during Easy Access registration. Registration dates can be found at **registrar.missouri.edu** or by calling 573-882-7881.

THE FOLLOWING POLICIES GOVERN THE REGISTRANT IN EASY ACCESS:

1. Students on academic dismissal status from any institution, including the University of Missouri, are not eligible to register until one year has elapsed.
2. Students expelled from any University of Missouri System school may not enroll through Easy Access.
3. Students may not transfer into a degree-granting division of the university during the term in which they are enrolled in Easy Access.
4. Transferring into a degree-granting division of the university requires completion of the regular application process. Contact the admissions office for more information at 573-882-7786.
5. Registration is open on a space-available basis. Space will not be available in graduate courses, law, medicine, veterinary medicine, journalism and most nursing courses. Space is normally unavailable in accountancy or computer science, along with some courses in other departments.
6. Students enrolling in Easy Access will not normally be eligible for financial aid.
7. The Office of the University Registrar serves as the "dean's office" for Easy Access students. Academic advising is generally not available, but registration staffers will give whatever assistance they can in arranging courses.
8. No graduate credit is available through Easy Access.

10. International students will be required to provide proof of a minimum TOEFL score of 500 (paper), 173 (computer), or 61 with no band below a 15 (Internet Based Test), or a 6.0 IELTS. Some departments require higher scores.
11. Registrants must be high school graduates.
12. Registration dates, refund dates, directory information and academic policies are available at **registrar.missouri.edu**.
13. Students are subject to appropriate university policies, including dismissal and probationary enrollment.
14. Students must apply and register under the proper residency and pay the proper fees. A pamphlet giving detailed information on tuition and residency rules may be obtained from the Office of Admissions, 230 Jesse Hall.

ENROLLMENT

Students who have completed work at another institution within the last 12 months must provide evidence of “good standing” or eligibility to re-enroll. (Evidence of good standing or eligibility to re-enroll should be sent to the MU Office of Admissions, 230 Jesse Hall, Columbia, MO 65211-1300 or fax to 573-882-7887 and must be received prior to the close of the sixth week of classes — third week in the summer — or your enrollment will be cancelled.) Students enrolling via Easy Access may not transfer to a school or college during the term in which they are enrolled under Easy Access. Failure to complete this form fully and accurately will void your admission. Providing misinformation concerning enrollment in other colleges or universities will also void your admission.
